

## Project 6 ~ 40<sup>th</sup> Birthday Card

I made this card for my husband's 40<sup>th</sup> Birthday, as he is not into any of the usual 'man' themes I decided to make it simple.

### Products used:

- ~ Craft Creations card from PK276-43
- ~ Stardream Card
- ~ White Card
- ~ Silver Shirts Peel off's
- ~ Alpha Chipboard Pack
- ~ Silver Embossing Powder
- ~ Silver & Pewter liquid pearls.
- ~ Making Memories Enamel Tiles ~ Birthday



### How to make:

- 1) Stick the coloured paper to the front of the card. I also covered the aperture and then cut out the centre and glued back the flaps. Trim off any excess.
- 2) Attach aqua coloured card into the aperture, I used a scrap of Stardream that I found in my stash.
- 3) Triple emboss the 4 and 0 with silver embossing powder to give the effect of metal and attach in the aperture.
- 4) Put the silver shirt peel offs onto acetate and cut them out. Layer with foam pads to give definition.
- 5) Matt and layer your greeting onto co-ordinating card.
- 6) Attach a Metal birthday embellishment onto the card.
- 7) Finally, decorate with silver and pewter liquid pearls.
